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**Neuroendoscopy Course:** "Incorporating Intracranial Endoscopy into Your Practice."

This course will take place on **Friday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2012 from 1 – 5 pm at the Shreveport Convention Center**

We have obtained permission from the Shreveport Convention Center to use cadaveric material during this hands-on course. The program will have didactic sessions regarding skull base endoscopy, intraventricular endoscopy, and endoscopic treatment of hydrocephalus. We would like the primary focus of the course to be hands-on sessions for both endoscopic transphenoidal approaches to the anterior cranial base and endoscopic third ventriculostomy.
